

Frequently Asked Questions About Our Pine Tree Community

Pine Tree is an Affordable Housing Community, Income Guidelines and Restrictions are in Place for All Perspective Purchasers.

- 1. What services are included with the site rent?
 - a. Pine Tree is a Manufactured Housing Community, and residents own their homes and pay a monthly rental fee on their lot in return for the included following services:
 - Property Taxes, Street Lighting, Trash and Recycling Collection, Plowing and General Maintenance of Community Roads, Water and Sewer Services, and Access to the Community Room.
- 2. Are there any rental homes at Pine Tree?
 - a. No, all available units at Pine Tree are for-sale only.
- 3. Can I purchase a home at Pine Tree and then rent it to someone else?
 - a. No, all homes in Pine Tree must be **Owner-Occupied**.
- 4. Can anyone purchase a home at Pine Tree?
 - a. No, all applicants **MUST** meet <u>affordable housing income guidelines.</u>
- 5. As a homeowner, what are my responsibilities?
 - a. Homeowners are responsible for: their utilities, electric, natural gas, and telephone/television/internet.
 - b. Cable and satellite TV are both available.
 - c. Homeowners are also responsible for the maintenance of their own site as well as the maintenance of their homes.





- 6. Is financing available?

 - b. Please note, there is an application process that incorporates homebuyer counseling as a required aspect for all financed purchases.
