



When temperatures drop below freezing and conditions pose a threat to individuals who are experiencing a loss of housing, emergency assistance becomes available through the CODE BLUE program.

Debt Relief And Financial Resolution Scams Are Everywhere, Learn What You Can Do To Protect You And Your Loved Ones!

According to the <u>Federal Trade Commission (FTC)</u>, debt relief service scams target consumers with significant credit card debt by falsely promising to negotiate with their creditors to settle or otherwise reduce consumers' repayment obligations. These operations often charge cash-strapped consumers a large up-front fee, but then fail to help them settle or lower their debts – if they provide any service at all.


Some Warning Signs To Be Aware Of Include:

- A debt relief company that asks for fees up front, before it settles any debts.
- The company guarantees it can eliminate your debt or reduce it by a particular amount in a set period of time.
- The company advises you to cut off communication with creditors.
- The company won't send you information about its services unless you provide financial information such as credit card account numbers and balances.

Some Ways You Can Do and Learn More:

- Report debt relief scams to the Federal Trade Commission<u>online</u> or by calling 1-800-382-4357.
- The <u>FTC</u> and the <u>U.S. Consumer Financial Protection Bureau</u> offer background and advice on debt settlement, credit counseling, and other ways to get out from under your financial liabilities.







Learn About NJ's Utility Assistance Programs!

<u>New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) Gift of Warmth</u> - Available to New Jersey Natural Gas customers, the *Gift of Warmth* program is designed to help those who have exhausted all other forms of energy assistance. Please Note:

- Only available to New Jersey Natural Gas customers
- One-time grant every 12 months, must be past-due
- Can reapply if denied initially for a balance below \$100

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) - *LIHEAP* helps residents with their heating/cooling bills & makes provisions for emergency heating system services & emergency fuel assistance within the program. Please Note:

- One-time grant every 12 months, must be past-due
- Can reapply if denied initially for a balance below \$100

Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) - LIHWAP benefits assist low-income households that are paying a high proportion of their income for drinking water and wastewater services. Eligible applicants will receive a benefit towards paying arrears. Please Note:

- · Helps avoid service disruptions and may restore services

Payment Assistance for Gas and Electric (PAGE) - The *PAGE* program is a statefunded assistance program that helps low to moderate-income families pay their utility bills. The program is designed to help those facing economic hardship and who are struggling to pay their electric and natural gas bills. Please note:

- One-time grant every 12 months, must be past due
- If denied initially for a balance below \$100, can reapply
- Undocumented households can apply

<u>Universal Service Fund (USF)</u> - The *USF* program is a service designed to help make electric and gas bills more affordable for qualified residents. Please note:

- Monthly credit and gas and electric for 12 months
- Credit amount is based on annual income and energy burden
- The minimum amount is \$5 (or \$60 per year)
